### **Measuring Earthquakes**

- Seismologists use a special machine called a seismograph to measure earthquakes
- Seismographs must be attached to bedrock in order to feel the earthquake vibrations



### RICHTER SCALE of earthquake energy:




	Description	<b>Occurrence</b>	In Population	Movement
1	SMALL	DAILY	every minute	small
2	SMALL	DAILY	every hour	small
3	SMALL	DAILY	every day	small
4	SMALL	DAILY	every week	moderate sudden
5	MODERATE	MONTHLY	every 10 years	strong sudden
6	MODERATE	MONTHLY	every 30 years	strong sudden
7	MAJOR	MONTHLY	every 50 years.	severe sudden
8	GREAT	YEARLY	every 100 years	very severe
9	GREAT	YEARLY	every 300 years	very severe
10	SUPER	RARELY	every 1000 years	extreme

### **Measuring Earthquakes**

- Seismologists use a measurement known as the Richter Scale to measure the intensity of earthquakes
  - The scale goes from 0 to as high as needed, but has

reached a 9.5 at its strongest





### **Earthquake Waves**

- Seismic waves are energy waves that travel outward from the source of the quake
- These aftershocks are smaller earthquakes and can cause damaged buildings to collapse
- Sometimes there are over 600 aftershocks



### **Earthquake Causes**


- When the rock in Earth's crust breaks from the pressure, it can create a fault
- Fault zones exist where tectonic plates meet
- There are 3 types of faults that can be created

# **Fault Types** Strike Slip A Normal Reverse

### Other Effects of Quakes

- <u>Tsunamis</u> are often triggered by underwater earthquakes
- These underwater quakes can also cause the loosening of sand, creating a temporary quicksand
