Classifying Structures

Natural Structures: Structures that are not made by people. These may provide shelter or play a role in an ecosystem





Manufactured Structures: Man Made structures. These are often modelled after natural structures



Design

Design refers to how structures are built.

There are three types of designs

Mass Structures

A mass structure can be made by piling or forming similar materials into a particular


shape or design.





Mass Structures


Layered look - Mass structures that are arranged in a layered pattern





Frame Structures

Frame structures have a skeleton of very strong material, which supports the rest of the structure.



Shell Structure

Shell structures have a thin, carefully shaped outer layer of material







Combination Structures

- Football helmets are a shell structure with a frame on the front
- Airplanes have a strong frame but are covered in a light shell
